## **PART 1 - INTRODUCTORY PROVISIONS**

### **Short title**

**1.1** This Act may be cited as the Grammatical and Typographical Amendments Act.

### **Executive oversight**

**1.2** The chairperson of the Legislature is responsible for the executive oversight of this Act.

### **Authority and application**

- 1.3** (a) This Act is enacted under
- (i) 13.11.1 of Chapter 13 Governance of the Maa-nulth Treaty, and
  - (ii) section 3.2(b) of the Constitution.
- (b) This Act applies to all Ka:'yu:'k't'h'/Che:k'tles7et'h' enactments.



## **PART 2 - GRAMMATICAL AND TYPOGRAPHICAL AMENDMENTS**

### **Grammatical and typographical amendments**

- 2.1** (a) Subject to subsection (b), the clerk may, by Order and on the advice of legal counsel to the Ka:'yu:'k't'h'/Che:k'tles7et'h' government, make an amendment to a Ka:'yu:'k't'h'/Che:k'tles7et'h' enactment to correct a grammatical or typographical error in that enactment.
- (b) An amendment made in accordance with subsection (a) must not in any way alter the intent of, or a right, duty or power provided for in, that enactment.





## **PART 3 - GENERAL PROVISIONS**

### **Commencement**

- 3.1** This Act comes into force on the date it is enacted.
